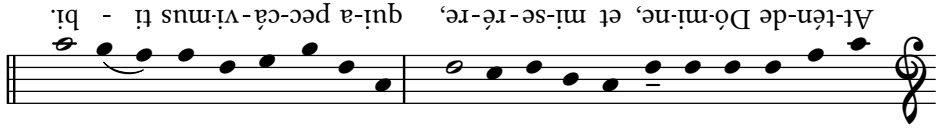


# SECOND SUNDAY OF LENT

 upon thee.

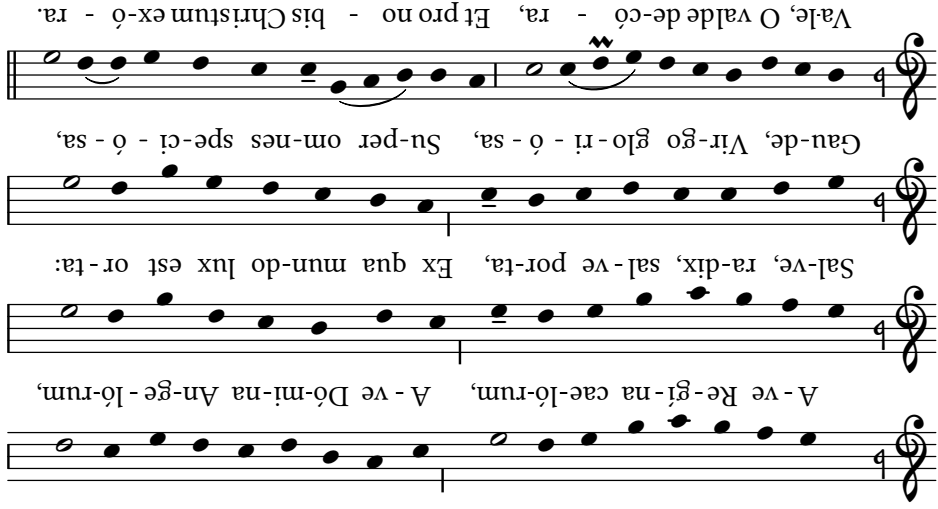
V. O right hand of the Father, O corner-
