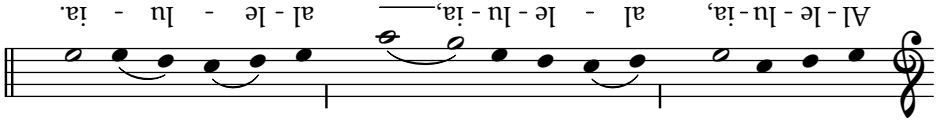


O Lord, nourishing Spirit, who art of one nature together with the Father and the Son, breathed forth from them both: have mercy on us.
